

# **Enforcement Performance Measures**


Q1 Report (July - September 2016)

# PM2 | Intake – Volume


Number of complaints closed or assigned to an investigator.

## PM2 | Intake - Cycle Time


Average number of days from complaint receipt, to the date the complaint was closed or assigned to an investigator.

Number of investigations closed (not including cases transmitted to the Attorney General).



(Includes intake and investigation)



#### PM4 | Formal Discipline - Volume




# PM4 | Formal Discipline – Cycle Time<sup>2</sup>

**Target Average:** 540 Days | **Actual Average:** 1,066 Days


