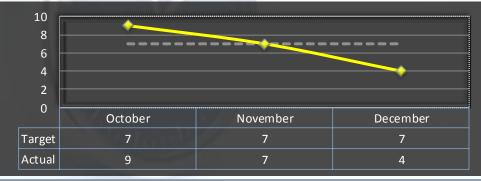


Intake

Q2 Average: 7 Days

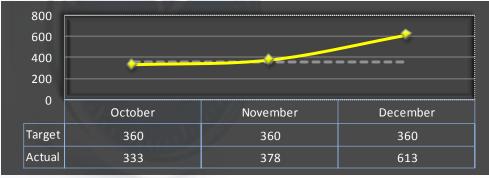


Formal Discipline

Q2 Average: 376 Days

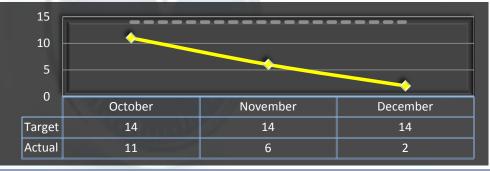


Probation Intake
