Governor Schwarzenegger issued Executive Order S 10-09 asking all state agencies to support the effort by helping to educate everyone living in California to accurately and completely fill out and return the 2010 Census Questionnaire. Census data are used to distribute Congressional seats to states, to make decisions about what community services to provide, and to distribute \$400 billion in federal funds to local, state and tribal governments each year.

DCA employees continue to amaze me in their generosity and knowledge about consumer protection information, and their willingness to educate others to be a smart and safe consumer. You can help inform your family and friends about the importance of completing the 2010 Census Questionnaire and eliminate the myths, especially to ethnic groups and consumers living in hard to count areas of the state, by volunteering to share value census information with your family and friends.

Employees who want to take part in reaching out to their community can obtain an information folder from our Outreach Unit. The folder contains FAQs, Web site addresses, and phone number for additional help, how to obtain questionnaires in different languages, and much more. 2010 Census FAQ's

What is the Census?

-The U.S. Census conducts a count of all people (citizens and non-citizens) living in the United States every 10 years.

Why should I complete the census form I receive?

- Your participation in the census is important for several reasons. Ensuring that the U.S. population is accurately counted helps determine what resources your community will receive in the future.

- The Census determines where billions of federal dollars go for hospitals, schools, infrastructure and public works projects, emergency services and other areas that receive federal money.

- The Census also helps to establish the number of seats your state has in the U.S. House of Representatives.

When should I expect my census form?

- March of 2010. Please make sure you answer the 10 questions and mail it back in the postage-paid envelope provided.

What if I do not fill it out?

- Not only is your participation in the census important, it is required by law. A census taker may visit your home and ask you the questions on the form if you do not mail your completed form.

Who is my personal information shared with?

- Your personal information that you provide for the census is protected under federal law which protects the confidentiality of your information. The information compiled by the Census Bureau is used to produce statistics.

Be Counted Centers


