**Cemetery and Funeral Bureau Advisory Committee Meeting
Legislation Update**

Legislation Update as of May 1st, 2022.

AB 351, (Garcia) Reduction of human remains and the disposition of reduced human remains.

- This bill would require the Cemetery and Funeral Bureau to license and regulate reduction facilities, which the bill defined as a location where natural, organic reduction of a human body occurs, and reduction facility managers, and would have enacted requirements applicable to reduction facilities, which are substantially similar to those for crematories and hydrolysis facilities.
- This bill would require a local registrar of births or deaths to issue permits for the disposition of reduced human remains
