What's New

Inactive License Disclosure

If you hold an inactive CPA license, beginning January 1, 2010, you must use the word "inactive" directly after any CPA title or designation you use. This applies to using the title "certified public accountant," the CPA designation, or any other reference that would suggest you are licensed by the CBA, on materials such as correspondence, Internet Web sites, business cards, nameplates, or name plaques.

Licensees renewing a license in an inactive status will be issued a pocket identification card reflecting an inactive status and will also be identified as holding an inactive license on the CBA's Web [License Look-up](#) feature.

The new requirement is the result of [Assembly Bill 117](#), which was recently signed into law. To stay up-to-date on information regarding CBA programs and activities, be certain to subscribe to [E-News](#).
