## DAN JACOBSON REAPPOINTED TO THE CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ACCOUNTANCY

SACRAMENTO – The California Board of Accountancy (CBA) is pleased to announce the reappointment of Dan Jacobson, Esq., by Speaker of the Assembly Anthony Rendon. Mr. Jacobson was originally appointed in September 2017 by Speaker Rendon.

Mr. Jacobson has practiced civil litigation law in California since 1988. He has served on the Board of Governors of the California Insurance Guarantee Association and as a Temporary Judge for the Orange County Superior Court. Mr. Jacobson is an Adjunct Professor of Law at Pacific West College of Law, the author of numerous scholarly articles, an expert witness-consultant in the field of property/casualty insurance, and the immediate past Chair of the Democratic Foundation of Orange County.

Mr. Jacobson is the recipient of the Richard J. O'Neill Lifetime Achievement Award for Excellence in Service and Leadership, the Chauncey Alexander Social Activism Award, a Certificate of Recognition from the California State Senate honoring his "long legal and philanthropic career," and was the subject of a speech delivered by Congressman Lou Correa on the floor of the House of Representatives entitled, "Honoring Legendary Orange County Attorney Dan Jacobson."

Mr. Jacobson earned a Juris Doctor Degree from Thomas Jefferson School of Law in 1987. He received his Bachelor of Science in Laws Degree from the same institution in 1986.

The CBA is comprised of eight members of the public, and seven members who are certified public accountants (CPA). Mr. Jacobson fills one public member seat. His term expires January 1, 2025.

Created by statute in 1901, the CBA's mandate requires that protection of the public shall be its highest priority in exercising licensing, regulatory, and disciplinary functions. The CBA currently regulates more than 113,000 licensees, the largest group of licensed accounting professionals in the nation, including individuals, partnerships, and corporations.
