CBA MEMBERS CORRIGAN AND SALAZAR TO CONTINUE ON NASBA BOARD OF DIRECTORS

SACRAMENTO – Nancy J. Corrigan, CPA, and Katrina L. Salazar, CPA, will continue in their roles as board members of the National Association of State Boards of Accountancy (NASBA) for another year, after an announcement listing the entire <u>2022-23 Board of Directors</u> was made at NASBA's recent 115th Annual Meeting in San Diego. The two members of the California Board of Accountancy (CBA) will retain their positions on NASBA's Board of Directors: Corrigan as Pacific Regional Director, and Salazar as a Director-at-Large.

The CBA is a member of NASBA, which is based in Nashville, Tennessee. NASBA's mission is to enhance the effectiveness and advance the common interests of state boards of accountancy in meeting their regulatory responsibilities, including consumer protection. Representatives from 53 of the 55 U.S. jurisdictions were in attendance at the Annual Meeting.
