

Q4 Report (April - June 2013)



Intake

Average cycle time from complaint receipt, to the date the complaint was assigned to an investigator.


Target: 10 Days Q4 Average: 8 Days



Intake & Investigation

Average cycle time from complaint receipt to closure of the investigation process. Does <u>not</u> include cases sent to the Attorney General or other forms of formal discipline.

Target: 200 Days Q4 Average: 226 Days



Formal Discipline

Average number of days to complete the entire enforcement process for cases resulting in formal discipline. (Includes intake and investigation by the Board, and prosecution by the AG)

Target: 540 Days

Q4 Average: 1,112 Days



Probation Intake

Average number of days from monitor assignment, to the date the monitor makes first contact with the probationer.

Target: 10 Days Q3 Average: 11 Days
