

## **Enforcement Performance Measures**


**Q2 Report** (October - December 2017)

Number of complaints closed or assigned to an investigator.






## PM2 | Intake - Cycle Time

**Target Average:** 30 Days | **Actual Average:** 9 Days



## PM4 | Formal Discipline - Volume


